All non-custody Municipal Court cases are continued Courthouse entry prohibited with COVID-19 symptoms or exposure

In response to a Missouri Supreme Court Order issued Monday regarding efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19, Municipal Court has postponed all hearings and trials through April 10 for cases where the defendant is not in custody. Municipal Court Presiding Judge Corey Carter also issued an order prohibiting persons who have been exposed to or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 from entering the courthouse.

- New court dates for continued cases will be mailed to defendants at the address on file.
 If you have a pending case, you must keep your address updated with the court by
 emailing court@kcmo.org or calling 816-513-2700. You also can find your new court
 date at www.kcmo.gov/court.
- All walk-in dockets through April 10 are cancelled.
- Probationers should contact their probation officers directly or by email at probation@kcmo.org or call 816-513-2700 for more information.
- Victims and City witnesses should contact the City Prosecutor's Office for information by email at witness@kcmo.org or by phone at 816-513-6750.
- Payments are encouraged to be made online at www.kcmo.gov/court with a debit or credit card; or by mail with a check to "Municipal Court" to P.O Box 219381, Kansas City, MO 64121-9381 or using the drop box in the lobby, also with a check. Please include your case number. Payment plan payments cannot be made online.
- However Municipal Court remains open and can accept payments in person at the customer service windows on the first floor.
